Pee Wee Soccer is a developmental program for children. Practices are scheduled once a week, with location and time determined by the coach. In this league, all participants will play in all games. It is crucial for adults to be positive role models. Please do not bring tobacco (smoking or chewing), alcohol or drugs of any kind to games or practices. Every player is required to wear shin guards with socks of equal or more length to cover the shin guards.

Divisions

Participants will be placed in divisions based on their age and experience. Coaches in both divisions will teach the basic fundamentals of soccer, good sportsmanship, and team work throughout the season.
